Reporting directly to the Headmaster, the Director is a member of the school leadership team and will manage ongoing improvements and enhancements to curriculum and instruction at LCA. The Director is the school's primary instructional leader and will provide academic leadership and support for all teachers in the areas of curriculum development and implementation, instructional effectiveness, and professional development.

The Director will work closely with the Principals in the continued development and implementation of a Christ-centered, comprehensive academic vision to prepare the school's students to engage faithfully in today's world. He or she will maintain a personal relationship with Christ, become involved in the community of a local evangelical church, and uphold congruency between the school's board-approved mission statement and all curricular activities, ensuring school programs are biblically aligned. The Director will also direct teachers in developing instructional goals, advise the administration and faculty concerning instructional methods and techniques, coordinate workshops for professional development, assist department chairs with resolving curricular challenges, and prepare reports concerning curricular matters for the board, committees, and other stakeholders.

Candidates must hold an advanced degree in education, preferably with a concentration in curriculum and instruction. Candidates holding doctoral degrees are preferred. They must have at least five years of experience teaching or building curricula and have the capacity to articulate and cultivate a Christian philosophy of education. To be considered, candidates should have classroom experience across multiple grade levels; current knowledge of educational technology; and a demonstrated ability to engage and work through professional conflict, lead a collaborative team, exercise discretion and professionalism in confidential student matters, and communicate clearly in speech and writing.
