Reporting directly to the Head of School, the High School Principal oversees all aspects of the high school; holds primary responsibility for setting and administering the division budget; and plays an active leadership role in communication with parents, admissions, teacher assignments, teacher supervision and evaluation, academic and non-academic program development, the development of an appropriate schedule that is reflective of the priorities and values of the division and the overall school, facilities stewardship and usage, and Christian life. He or she collaborates with the Head of School, Associate Head of School, lower and middle school principals, assistant heads of school, department chairs, grade chairs, and high school counselor to ensure program consistency and continuity; works closely with the Dean of Students on all student discipline matters and honor offenses; oversees the student drug testing program; participates with the Associate Head of School in evaluating curriculum, developing new courses, and the hiring and retaining of faculty and staff; coordinates, oversees, and leads the grade chair structure in the High School; oversees baccalaureate and graduation preparations; plans monthly division meetings; attends extra-curricular events; and teaches one class.

The ideal candidate will have a graduate degree in a relevant discipline and previous experience in school leadership; strong interpersonal, communication, organizational, and leadership skills; a positive attitude, a collaborative mindset toward decision making, a humble spirit, and endless energy.
