As a member of the administrative council, the Middle School Head will report to the Head of School and serve as direct administrator of Middle School students, faculty, and staff.

The Middle School Head will maintain congruency between the School's mission statement and all activities of the division; monitor the climate of the division through both qualitative and quantitative measures; and effectively articulate the division's programs, expectations, behavioral guidelines, and other necessary information to all constituencies. He or she will supervise and support faculty in the development and implementation of curriculum and make recommendations regarding the hiring, retention, and assignment of faculty. The Middle School Head will also focus on student well-being and take a proactive approach to student discipline; advise and monitor the academic progress of students; work with students having academic or other difficulties; and coordinate co-curricular and extra-curricular activity programs for the division.

The ideal candidate will have at least a master's degree with teaching and administrative experience in a middle school setting. He or she will appreciate the past but also employ a creative vision for the future in line with the School's mission; embrace the whole child educational philosophy; and put the students first at all times. The ideal candidate will be an effective communicator; an open-minded and driven individual; a team player; and a strong relationship builder.

Episcopal School of Baton Rouge is a college-preparatory educational community of around 950 students in grades prekindergarten through twelve. Episcopal is known historically for its strong academic program, its attention to the spiritual lives of its students, and its wide range of opportunities for student education and development.
