He or she will excel in being relational, will be comfortable as an adaptive problem solver, and will demonstrate responsibility, initiative, creativity, self-reliance, and a high level of productivity. This person must be hard working, detail-oriented, level-headed in stressful situations, and proficient with technology.

Cannon School is an independent school located in the greater Charlotte area, serving more than 900 students in grades junior kindergarten through twelve. With over 400 students in the Upper School, Cannon holds as its mission both the nurturing of relationships and the engagement of every learner. In twenty years at its present location, the physical campus has grown to include Upper School and Middle School additions, technology labs and makerspaces, a performing arts center, and a strength and conditioning facility.
