Southern Teachers is assisting Augusta Preparatory Day School as it seeks a passionate and energetic Director of Athletics to lead its vibrant athletic department serving grades six through twelve as an important component of its educational program. Reporting to the Head of School, the Director will work closely with school leadership to advance the school's strategic vision.

The Director of Athletics will administer the school's program of extracurricular athletics and assume responsibility for the scheduling and supervision of all intramural and interscholastic athletic events, including game officials, team physicians, and security personnel for home contests and transportation for away contests. The Director will develop and implement appropriate rules governing the conduct of athletic activities, ensure compliance with regulations promulgated by GISA, and participate in all association and region meetings. He or she will verify each athlete's eligibility according to established physical and academic requirements for participation in each sport and obtain written parent permission for each student to participate. The Director will manage the department budget and the maintenance of all athletic facilities, supplies, and equipment. He or she will plan recognition programs for athletes, participate in all fundraising events of the Booster Club, and work closely with the college counseling team to assist eligible athletes in pursuing intercollegiate athletic programs.

The ideal candidate will have a master's degree in an appropriate discipline, experience as a coach or administrator in an independent school, and an understanding of the importance of strong academics balanced by co-curricular and extracurricular participation. He or she will have strong administrative, organizational, and communication skills and the ability to relate with students, coaches, and parents. In addition, this person will be an inspirational, innovative, collaborative, and energetic leader who understands the importance of strong decision-making and is comfortable in dealing with issues related to civility, integrity, and individual responsibility as part of Augusta Prep's shared values. The right person for this position will be well-served by a combination of patience, confidence, enthusiasm, humility, and humor.

Augusta Prep was formed in 1988 upon the merger of Augusta Preparatory School (grades 7-12, founded in 1960) and Augusta Country Day School (grades K5-6, founded in 1972). As the only nonsectarian, independent, college-preparatory school in the Augusta area, APDS serves students in preschool through grade twelve, offering a challenging curriculum and outstanding fine arts, athletic, and community service programs.
