Responsible for supervising and mentoring a group of 25 Middle School faculty; the Director will collaboratively work with them to research and implement best practices in differentiated instruction and nurture their professional growth. He or she will foster a safe and welcoming climate for teaching and learning; develop relationships with and support both students and families in the division; coordinate co-curricular and extra-curricular activity programs for the division; and guide students and families through the high school placement process.

The ideal candidate will have at least a master's degree and significant teaching and/or administrative experience in a middle school setting. He or she must have a well-developed understanding of the unique academic and personal characteristics of young adolescents; a familiarity with the pedagogic approaches which stimulate middle school learners; and strong interpersonal skills.

Established in 1969, St. George's Episcopal School serves 402 students from age one through grade eight in the historic Uptown of New Orleans. The Middle School serves grades five through eight and provides a leveled curriculum designed to challenge a range of learners. Students with language-based learning differences benefit from the expertise of faculty with specialized training while advanced curricula in language arts and mathematics allow children to excel beyond grade level. Taken together, St. George's Middle School community is one which embraces students' evolving identities, hones their character strengths, and celebrates their individual interests.
