The Associate Dean supports class sponsors, advisors, and the Dean of Students; handles duties as necessary for the general function of the Office of the Dean of Students; and has substantial individual responsibility in school life outside of the Office's purview. He or she assumes the responsibilities of the Dean of Students in the Dean's absence.
