The Director will be responsible for managing the enrollment process from admission to re-enrollment, through the transition of students back into mainstream schools. While most of the work will center on admissions, the Director will also be responsible for fundraising activities and events. He or she will interact with the parent organization, guiding them through fundraising events, and managing the annual fund.

Successful candidates will have an understanding of learning differences and experience in admissions and enrollment management, event planning, and marketing. Although the marketing aspect of this position is minimal, it is essential. The Director will need to have great people skills, a desire to help parents make good educational decisions, and a flexible attitude. An ability to interpret psychological testing or a background in counseling would be advantageous.

Located in Mount Pleasant, just across the bridge from Charleston and minutes from downtown and two beautiful beaches, Trident Academy is one of thirteen schools in the United States accredited by the Academy of Orton-Gillingham, the gold standard in multi-sensory education, and one of just nine Orton-Gillingham accredited training centers.
