Southern Teachers is assisting Whitefield Academy as it seeks a Director of Instructional Technology to support faculty, staff, and administration in integrating technology into classroom instruction and school culture. Reporting to the academic dean as a member of the Instructional Leadership team, the Director will provide expertise in how to integrate technology into best practices of teaching and will monitor execution of WA's strategic plans for instructional technology and digital stewardship.

To lead the implementation of technology integration standards throughout all levels, the Director will establish and maintain easily accessible instructional technology website listings, software databases, and reference resources for faculty that support the effective integration of technology into instruction. He or she will collaboratively develop and monitor systems for understanding successful technology integration and will make recommendations to IT support regarding care, maintenance, and replacement of classroom hardware. The Director will design and implement a professional development program to support technology integration into classrooms, will assist teachers in developing and modeling exemplary technology-integrated lessons, and will train new teachers in technology integration. He or she will keep current on research trends and significant developments in the area of technology, curriculum, instruction, and assessment; review current and future technology programs; and recommend and lead improvements in programs for WA students, such as use of devices in classrooms for student learning (bring-your-own, laptops, Chromebooks, iPads, etc.), STEAM initiatives, and virtual or blended course offerings.

Candidates must have five years of successful teaching experience, ideally in multiple divisions (lower, middle, upper schools); prior success in establishing technology integration; and at least two years in an instructional technology role. They must have excellent oral and written communication skills and the ability to develop strategic plans for technology integration, to work collaboratively and effectively with people across various proficiency levels, and to manage a number of substantive short-term and long-term goals simultaneously. Candidates with specialized technology certifications and/or advanced degrees in teaching or instructional technology are preferred. In addition, the Director must embrace the school's vision and strive for excellence by furthering its mission, commit to living under the lordship of Christ, model a consistent daily walk with Him, and be a Christian role model in speech, actions, and attitudes, which contributes to the school's spiritual atmosphere. Candidates must affirm the school's Statement of Faith; evidence the fruit of the Spirit in the nurturing of relationships with other staff members, students, families, and the community at large; and be actively involved in a local church.

Located in metro-Atlanta, Whitefield Academy is a Christ-centered college-preparatory school that enrolls about 800 students, prekindergarten through grade twelve.
