Southern Teachers is assisting The Woodlands Christian Academy as it seeks an academic administrator for a new position on the school's leadership. Reporting directly to the School Principal, the new Director will collaborate with administrators, teachers, and accrediting agencies in maintaining, assessing, and improving an integrated, relevant, rigorous K-12 curriculum. The Director will lead the collaborative work of establishing a new five-year academic plan, which also means setting the direction for teacher in-services, workshops, and division discussions to assess and improve the current curriculum in the areas of biblical integration, alignment with standards, technology integration, and incorporation of 21st century learning and innovation skills. The Director will implement textbook replacement cycle and written curriculum policies and will ensure that accreditation standards for curriculum are maintained and that plans are developed to address needs for curricular improvements documented by accreditation agencies.

The Director will help teachers follow best practices for learning, including frequent classroom visits and support in employing a variety of instructional methods, particularly in helping students identified with special learning needs. The Director will offer guidance to ensure that teachers' curricular plans are aligned with the school's curriculum guides for each grade and content area. He or she will help develop clear, specific assessment criteria outlining academic expectations for each new unit, such as rubrics generated by teachers and students collaboratively and review of assessment data, as well as high-stakes testing preparation. Overall, the Director is responsible for all matters related to instruction, faculty professional development, assessment of learning, and curricular innovation.

Candidates should have at least three years of teaching experience, advanced degrees in curriculum or three years of curriculum coordinator experience, current teacher or administrator certification, and experience with accreditation processes. They should possess well-developed communication and organizational skills and the ability to facilitate collaboration across school divisions and content areas. TWCA faculty and school leaders must have received Jesus Christ as their personal Savior, believe that the Bible is God's Word and standard for faith and living, and be in whole-hearted agreement with the school's Statement of Faith and Christian philosophy of education.

The Woodlands Christian Academy enrolls 580 students in prekindergarten through grade twelve on a beautiful forty-acre campus in The Woodlands, a master-planned community just thirty miles north of Houston. TWCA is a college preparatory school that integrates learning with biblical faith and challenges students to reach their highest potential—spiritually, academically, physically, and socially—for the glory of Jesus Christ.
